

EGADZ TEEN PARENTING VOLUNTEER

Updated as of Sept. 25th, 2018

The Teen Parenting program is welcoming volunteers who would like to work with our program and get experience working with teen parents and their children. The potential volunteer who would take the position available would be asked to participate and assist with the supervision of recreational activities in the community and within the EGADZ youth centre. The purpose of these recreational activities is to help teach the parents to be an active participant in the recreational activities in their children, teach patience, provide opportunities for physical activity for both the children and the parents, and to facilitate further attachment and bonding between the parents and their children.

The following tasks may be required of the potential volunteer:

1. Assist with supervision of parents and children when on outings in the community.
2. Participate in recreational activities and build rapport with the parents and their children.
3. Assist with any set up and clean-up of activities.
4. May have the potential to help plan activities and to keep an eye out for activities in the community that the parents and children could participate in.
5. Assist with bigger events such as birthday parties and holiday-themed parties (Halloween, Christmas). This could be helping to decorate, participating and supervising activities, preparing snacks, helping clean up, etc.
6. May be asked to help with general organization and tidying of areas such as the child-care room, children's clothing closet, etc.

The ideal candidate for this volunteer position would be someone who has an interest in working with teen parents and children, is compassionate, flexible and trustworthy, and who has knowledge of Indigenous issues and culture. Must be available in the evenings. The days that we would require a volunteer the most would be Wednesday evenings and Friday evenings from 6:00 PM-8:30 PM.
